2023 Scholarship Official Information and Guidelines:

Any Robins Financial Credit Union member who will graduate from high school in 2023, and who will be attending a college or university in the state of Georgia is eligible to apply. Other conditions that must be met include:

- Applicants must submit their completed Scholarship Application packet by 12:00 p.m. Friday, March 24, 2023 at https://www.robinsfcu.org/money-smart-programs. Applications will be disqualified if they are missing any of the required information or if the application is not received by the deadline. No exceptions, mail, hard copy email fax or phone applications will be accepted.
- 2. Applicants must upload a letter of acceptance from the in-state college or university they plan to attend.
- Applicants must upload a copy of their most recent high school report card or transcript to include their cumulative GPA. Does not have to be an official transcript.
- Applicants must upload two letters of recommendation. The letters should not be from the applicant's family members, but from members of the community. (Examples: teachers, managers, pastors, etc.)
- 5. Applicants must upload a one-page typed essay answering the following questions: How will receiving a scholarship from Robins Financial Credit Union help you achieve your career/life goals?
- Applicants MUST be a member of Robins Financial Credit Union. You may NOT use a parent/guardian's account.

All applicants will be notified of their selection status, by mail, no later than Friday, April 21, 2023.

Additional Information: Only applications submitted via Robins Financial Credit Union Scholarship webpage will be considered for review. Requests submitted by mail, hard copy, email, fax or phone will not be considered for review and will be directed to follow application instructions as detailed on this page. Awarded scholarship funds of \$2,000 will be issued directly to the in-state college or university on behalf of the recipient upon providing proof of enrollment. If verification of enrollment is not received, or student does not attend an in-state college or university, funds will be forfeited.
