The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Steve Stanley, Chair; Lewis DeWeese; Terry Bramlett; and Bobby Bearden. Sandra Mercier, Vice-Chair, was absent.

The meeting was called to order by Steve Stanley, Chair.

Art Hubbard, Assistant Superintendent, gave Board Members an update on construction projects. Mr. Hubbard stated the plumbing and gas trim have been completed at the Maintenance Facility, and he is awaiting garage door openers.

Mr. Hubbard stated the State Fire Marshal gave final approval on the Blue Ridge Elementary School restroom renovations project, and the project is now complete.

Mr. Hubbard stated the following items have been completed at the Fannin County High School Guidance Suite: Drywall, painting, electrical rough, and data cabling. The State Fire Marshal did 80% inspection. The flooring installation is underway and estimated to move in before Thanksgiving Break.
