# 2025 Prattville High School Graduation Thursday, May 22nd at Stanley-Jensen Stadium - 7:00 p.m.

- Graduation practice is at 9:00 a.m on Thursday, May 22nd at Stanley-Jensen Stadium. Students must participate in practice or will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- We will require tickets to enter the stadium for graduation. Tickets are free and should not be sold.
- Students will be given **fifteen** admission tickets for their family. Children, under two, who do not require a seat, can be admitted without a ticket. If your family has concerns or obstacles with the 15-ticket limit, please contact Dr. Farris to discuss hardships and accommodations.
- Doors will open at 5:30. There are no reserved seats.
- Students must sign when picking up their tickets on May 19th in the MANE from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. No student or parent can pick up tickets for another student. Enter through the side entrance. All tickets will be in envelopes.
- There is a plan to live stream the graduation ceremony. More details to come.

## \*\*\*\* SENIOR Information for Commencement Ceremony\*\*\*\*

#### **FEMALES:**

- 1. Flat shoes are best suited for walking on the stage and grass- No flip-flops, slides, bedroom slippers, tennis shoes, or Crocs.
- 2. Wear a dress that is white or a light solid color and white/beige shoes no higher than 4".
- 3. Jewelry should be modest.

#### **MALES:**

- 1. Wear dark dress pants/slacks (no jeans, shorts, cut offs, etc.)
- 2. Wear dark dress shoes. No flip-flops, slides, bedroom slippers, tennis shoes, Crocs, or work boots.
- 3. Wear a white shirt and dark tie. Do not wear a coat beneath your gown.
- \*\*\* Students will be pulled from the lineup at graduation if he/she does not adhere to the above dress code.

### **BOTH FEMALES/MALES:**

- 1. Do not bring purses, bags, or cell phones to line up.
- 2. No texting or phone calls during the graduation ceremony!
- 3. No silly string, beach balls, artificial noisemakers, or balloons etc., will be allowed in the stadium.
- 4. No chewing gum.
- 5. Caps should be worn level on the top of your head.
- 6. Tassels are to be placed on the right side of your cap. **Decorated caps are NOT ALLOWED during the ceremony.**
- 7. Nothing is to be worn on your gown with the exception of **school endorsed academic honor cords or stoles.**
- 8. Receive your diploma with your left hand. Leave your right hand free to shake hands with Dr. Farris.
- 9. Walk gracefully and dignified across the stage. Excessive displays for attention are prohibited.
- 10. You are only receiving your diploma cover once coming across the stage. The diploma will be given to you after the graduation ceremony.
