The 2021-2022 school year vaccination requirements for children entering Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 7th and 11th grades are:

- All students entering Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten and 7th grade must have had two (2) varicella vaccinations.
- All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination.
- $\bullet$  Effective July 2020, all students entering or transferring into the 11th grade will need proof of a meningococcal conjugate booster (MCV4) shot, unless their 1st dose was received on or after their 16th birthday.

These requirements are in addition to the existing school vaccination requirements.

Your child's vaccines are not up to date. After September 30, 2022, your child will not be allowed to come to school. Please provide the school with the appropriate documentation that your child's vaccines are up to date (FORM 3231).

In addition to the required vaccines, please talk to your child's doctor about other vaccines, like flu, HPV and Hepatitis A that your child may need.

If you have questions about vaccines that are required for school, please call your child's doctor or the school nurse.
