### **PROGRAMS FOR PUPILS WITH DISABILITIES**

In some cases a local district staffing committee may identify the North Country Charter Academy as the least restrictive environment and appropriate placement for the academic portion of the student's IEP or 504 plan. In such a case, the student's sending district retains responsibility for the development and maintenance of the student's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 plan, including all necessary support services, adaptive equipment and assistive technology. The sending district in all cases shall retain all responsibility for compliance with the mandates of IDEA and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
