We are thrilled to continue to use our newly adopted math program, Eureka Math Squared, to assist students in learning the math standards. We will be using Eureka Math Squared for the second year. We are happy to have complete campus alignment with our instructional practices. Eureka Squared is designed to support problem-based instruction and is built on a coherent learning progression. Eureka Square offers an engaging approach to math, giving students skills, understandings, and practices that develop a deep sense of numbers.

Students in grades kindergarten through sixth will continue to use the Journey (HMH) curriculum to help master English Language Arts (ELA) standards. Students in seventh and eighth grade will use the curriculum Collections, which is a comprehensive, literacy program that provides a balanced approach to teaching reading, writing, speaking, and listening using a collection of authentic reading texts and writing workshops.
