



Procedure for Medical Equipment / Assistive Devices at School

If your child needs medical or assistive equipment at school (like crutches, a walking boot, wheelchair, cane, walker, nebulizer, or other devices), please provide a note from their healthcare provider. The note should include:

- The medical diagnosis requiring the use of the device
- The anticipated duration of use
- Specific instructions for school health personnel regarding its use
- Any activity restrictions (e.g., PE, recess, sports), including the duration of restrictions
- The healthcare provider's signature and contact information

Please remember:

- Families must provide their child's equipment. The school does not supply devices for daily use.
- Wheelchairs in the health room are for **emergencies only**.
 - To ensure the safe and appropriate use of medical equipment at school, make sure your child knows how to safely use the equipment before bringing it to school.
 - Let the school nurse know right away if your child's health condition or needs change.
