Lanier County School District Goals

Goal 1: The District shall increase the percentage of students scoring proficient and distinguished in English Language Arts on the Georgia Milestones Assessment by 5% as compared to the 2025-2026 scores.

Action Step 1: Provide professional development to administrators and other leaders to build knowledge of instructional leadership.

Action Step 2: Develop a districtwide Tier 1 instructional framework that establishes clear systems and processes for effective Tier 1 literacy instruction focusing on instructional practices, curriculum resources, and assessments.

Increase Literacy Skills

As a school - We will provide quality instruction through standards based classrooms, utilizing the Georgia Standards of Excellence. We will use diagnostic, formative, and summative assessments to monitor learning and inform instruction to increase student achievement. We will provide resources to improve Lexile levels, websites to promote vocabulary development, and Literacy Night to interact with families, display student work, and create a fun environment that promotes family literacy.
