# PARKING LOT

## RULES & PROCEDURES

Greeting's Havasupai Families. These are the parking lot rules and procedures that we have put in place to keep ALL students and families safe.

### Parking Lot General Rules

1. SAFETY is our #1 Priority.
2. **SLOW** down through parking lot, drive through, and crosswalks.
3. Parking lot, this is not a drive through. You **MUST** park.
4. Right drive through lane along the sidewalk: you may park long enough to pick up your student. Please pull as far forward as you can. Once your child is safely in your car, you will pull into the right or left lane to exit the parking lot.
5. **DO NOT** ask your child to cross in front of traffic. **DO NOT** cross in front of traffic to pick up your child. You may see your child, others may not.
6. If you park and walk to the front of the school building, **USE** the crosswalk.

### Before School Options

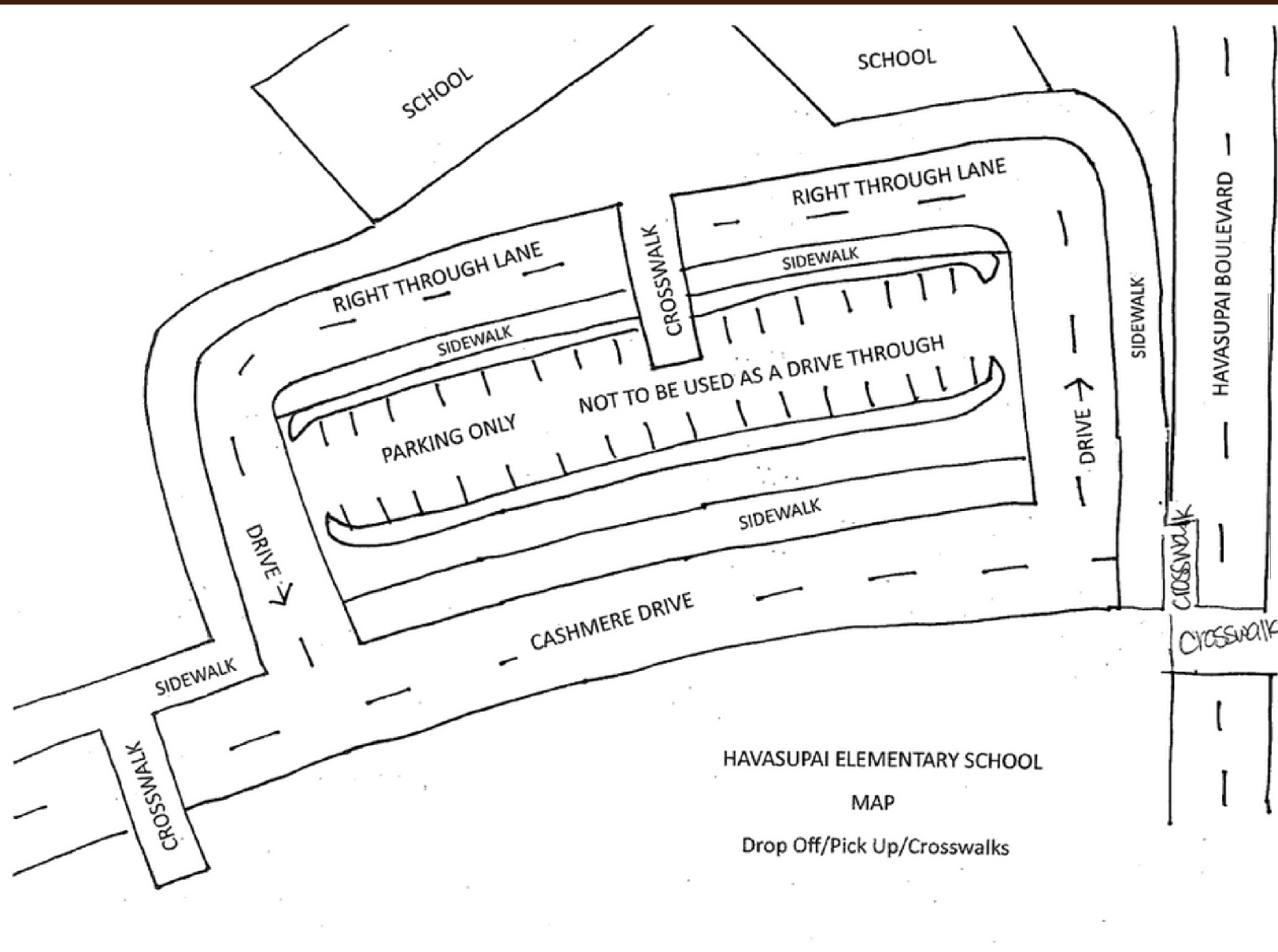
1. Park in a lined space and walk your child on the sidewalk and use the crosswalk. **DO NOT** drop off students in the parking lot; **MUST** use right drive through lane.
2. Drive up and use the right drive through lane to the sidewalk in front of the school. Drop off as far up as you can to avoid backing up traffic. Your child can safely walk on the sidewalk up to the school. **DO NOT** park in this lane. Please only stop briefly for drop-off/pickup if you see your child in view.
3. Students dropped off on Cashmere **MUST** use sidewalks and crosswalks; students **MAY NOT** cut through the parking lot.

### After School Options

1. Park in a lined space and meet your child on the sidewalk using the crosswalk. Return to your parked car using the crosswalk.
2. Drive up and use the right drive through lane along the sidewalk in front of the playground. Pull up as far as you can in the pickup line in a safe manner. You may park long enough to pick up your student.
3. Please **DO NOT** cross through cars or the parking lot. Always **USE** sidewalks and crosswalk.
