

HRMS Cell Phone Policy

In order to maximize instructional time and increase student focus, HRMS is instituting a zero tolerance cell phone policy. Students may have their phones on campus, but phones must be powered off and remain in his/her book bag for the entire school day. This policy also includes smart watches and earbuds/headphones. Listed below are the consequences for violating the policy:

1st Offense: The student will be given a warning.

2nd Offense: An office referral will be written. The student's phone, smart watch, and/or earbuds will be confiscated and turned in to an administrator. The student will be able to retrieve his/her confiscated item(s) at the end of the school day.

<u>All Future Offenses</u>: An office referral will be written. The student's phone, smart watch, and/or earbuds will be confiscated and turned in to an administrator. A parent/guardian must come to the school to retrieve the student's confiscated item(s).
