

Textbooks in Hickman County Schools

The Hickman County School System adopts new textbooks and instructional materials following the Tennessee Department of Education's 8-year Adoption Process.

Textbooks are adopted on a cycle but that timeline can be extended as needed at the state level. [TN Textbook Review Cycles](#)

The State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission prepares a recommended textbook list in the Fall of an adoption year, which is sent to the State Board of Education for consideration. Upon approval by the State Board, the list of textbooks and instructional materials is made public and districts follow procedures set by the state to select and adopt these materials.

State Guidelines

The state textbook adoption process is administered in accordance with the statutory requirements as set forth in Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 22 and the Rules and Policies of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission.
