Students:

Monday is the first day of EOC or End of Course testing. The EOC tests are similar to TCAP tests that you have taken in the past. We will be taking the English EOC next week Monday through Friday and Monday of the following week during your English class. We will be taking the Math EOC Wednesday, April 26 through Tuesday, May 2 during your Math class. We will run on Alternate Schedules on Testing days. A copy of the Alternate Schedules has been emailed to you.

Please make every effort to be present at school and avoid being tardy to school on testing days.

Students will not be allowed to have any electronic devices in the testing room – that means no cell phones, no smart watches, no airpods, etc. You might want to leave these items at home on testing days. However, if you want to bring them to school, you WILL NOT be allowed to keep them in your pocket. They will have to be placed in your backpack or given to your teacher and stored in the hallway during testing. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Please be prepared to take these tests seriously. Coffee County Board of Education policy states that End of Course tests will count a percentage of each student's second semester grade. It is very important that you do your best on these tests. We want your test score to be an accurate reflection of what you have learned in your class.
