The binder should be durable enough to last the whole year. We recommend the Mead 5-star, or any cloth/poly type. The ones with zippers can be especially useful. It is fine to get a standard binder, but you may end up needing to replace it within the year.

□ 6 – different 3-hole punched folders that will fit in the binder

Poly type folders are recommended because they do not rip as easily. Do not label or write on any folders. Thin folders can be 3-hole punched if needed. **Pronged folders cannot be used.**

- □ 1 pencil box or bag to keep in locker for supplies (a large Ziploc works)


