A little bit about punctuality and attendance:

If in a school year, a student is late every day by	They would have lost approximately	or they would have missed approximately
5 minutes	3.5 Days from School	18 Lessons
10 Minutes	7 Days from School	35 Lessons
15 minutes	10 Days from School	50 Lessons
20 Minutes	14.5 Days from School	73 Lessons
30 Minutes	22 Days from School	110 Lessons

Also, when your student is late, it <u>doesn't just affect them</u>. It disrupts the entire classroom. When a teacher has started the lesson, and students come in tardy - going to their lockers, unpacking their supplies and getting settled at their desks - it is very disruptive to the educational process. Further, many classes will have already switched classrooms, so the tardy students disrupt a <u>second class</u> as well. Tardy students are taking away educational time from students who arrive on time and are ready to learn. For this reason, when a student arrives late they may be asked to **WAIT IN THE OFFICE until the start of the next class period**.

We ask that you have your student(s) in the building <u>BEFORE</u> 8:00 a.m. so they are settled and ready for Pledge and Prayers when the bell rings.
