Transforming After School Pick Up!

PikMyKid is the key to a safe and organized school dismissal! We'll be using it the first day of school! Just follow a few easy steps, so you'll be ready to start.

To get started, complete the following steps today:

✓ **Download the app**

Download the app from your smartphone's app store for free and get registered!

✓ **Register**

Once you have downloaded the PikMyKid phone app, you will press the "Register" button and fill out the form.

After you press submit, you will be sent an OTP code by text message. Please enter this code into the next screen. This will complete your registration process!

Choose your child's Pickup Mode:

Change your child's Mode of Pickup as needed up to 2:30 pm each day. There are four choices for **Primary Mode of Pickup**: Car line, Walker, Bus, After School. **To get you started, we chose Carline for everyone. However, you need to change the mode if you are using one of the other three options.**

- a. Select **Walker** if you are walking up to the dismissal area by the gym. *Please note that for safety reasons, we prefer that parents use the Carline.*
- b. Select **Bus** if your child is picked up 1K Nation, Boys & Girls Club, NFL YET, or PAL. After selecting Bus, use the drop down to select the "Bus Route". If you are using a specific Day Care Van please send the exact name of the Day Care to drumschlag@guardiancatholic.com so we can add their name to the drop down list.
- c. Select **After School** if your child is in Champions. First select After School; then select Champions from the drop down.

Did you know that in PikMyKid you can...

2. **Delegate someone else to pick up your child.** The parent is in total control of who you share your child's PikMyKid ID# with. The fact that someone else has the ID means that you gave them the ID. To get another person started:
 - a. Add them as a Secondary Parent (a grandparent, for example)
 - b. Have them download the PikMyKid app to their phone; they will need your child's PikMyKid ID#.

Stagger arrival times within the dismissal timeframe which is 2:55 pm to 3:25 pm.

All cars should be on the parking lot no sooner than 2:00 and no later than 3:25 pm.

PikMyKid is a time-saving program when used correctly. Here are some important reminders that make the program function correctly and will speed up the process even more:

- ✓ **Announce your arrival on the PikMyKid App** when you arrive at the parking lot. When you announce your child(ren) as a Car Rider or as a Walker, each child's name appears on the screens of the staff loading cars and on the screen in the classroom prompting teachers to send your child(ren) to the correct pickup area. (If there's no announcement in PikMyKid, your child(ren's) names do not show up. The entire car line is slowed down when staff have to run around to find a child whose name and pickup location are not announced.)
- ✓ **Share carline procedures with anyone you've delegated to pick up your child.** Everyone is asked to stay in the car line. No one may park and walk up to the white gate area to pick up a child.
- ✓ After 3:30 we do not have staff to supervise children who have not been picked up.
Beginning Tuesday, Sept. 7, late fees will be charged for picks up later than 3:30 pm.
