Letter from Fr. Thomas, Pastor

Blessed Solemnity of Corpus Christi, everyone!



The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is the source and summit of our entire Catholic life, since "It" is really the Second Person of the Trinity, Jesus Himself—truly and substantially present in what looks like but IS NOT a piece of unleavened bread or a chalice of wine!!! In honor of this central Mystery of our lives, we will have a Eucharistic procession around the block after the Saturday and Sunday 5:00 p.m. Masses and inside the church after the 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. And to help you and me to grow in trust that Holy Communion is union with the real Person of Jesus, and not with a thing (bread and wine), the Lord Himself has given us all sorts of Eucharistic miracles down through the ages. This time last year we were hosting the gift of the Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit in our hall when Dr. Richard Bernatchez came with his wife and gave a presentation on Eucharistic miracles. A few days ago a parishioner shared with me a little-but-not-so-little miracle experienced at Mass during the quiet time after receiving Jesus in Holy Communion. The Father came to the person and revealed/highlighted how much this person needs physical touch from family members, and how important it is to recognize that and how—even if others do not provide that for the person—the Father wants to and does provide that. And then the Father gave the person an experience of physical touch from Him. Pretty wonderful, no?

So, in this second year of our three-year Eucharistic revival, I encourage each of you (and myself!) to take extra time with the Lord Jesus and the Father and the Holy Spirit after Mass (They never come alone, but always together!)—especially if not much extra time has been provided after Communion for that quiet listening. And again, remember that everyone is different, so how you spend those quiet minutes after receiving our Lord depends on what best moves your heart to love Him in return (see the quote from St. Teresa in today's Quiet Listening Prayer section of the bulletin on Page Five). 1) You can slowly go over the readings again from the Mass and stop and talk to Jesus when a particular word or phrase begins to move your heart; or 2) you can gently pray a decade of the Rosary, thinking about the mystery of the Lord and how He is truly present to you right now; or 3) you can dialogue with Him about something going on in your real life right now; or 4) you could pray the Jesus Prayer, gently breathing in while saying the Holy Name of Jesus and breathing out while saying a word that expresses your desire for Him (e.g., "mercy").



This Friday is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, burning with Divine Love for you personally! You could join the thousands who, in the face of mounting opposition, will be bearing witness on Friday, June 16, to the treasure of the Catholic life outside Dodger Stadium (see the various Catholic news outlets for details), and you can also join us for a PARISH BROOMBALL GAME that evening at 10:15 p.m. at the Pasadena Skate Center (no skates or hockey sticks needed/allowed; just bring your tennis shoes and a helmet (not required)). Please call the office for details if you are planning to come for broomball, so that we can send you a liability release form to fill out ahead of time. There is a suggested donation of \$10 per person.

The image of St. Joseph as he's sleeping is a powerful reminder of his peaceful surrender to God's divine plan for his life. One night an angel came to Joseph in a dream and told him that Mary's baby was the Son of God. The angel told Joseph to marry Mary and to name her baby Jesus. Jesus was to be the Savior of the world. Joseph obeyed the angel and married Mary. The statue is 16X3 inches and is simple in the way Joseph was himself, wrapped in his humble robes. Yet the symbolic value of this image is strong. While asleep, St Joseph received messages from God, who warned him about the danger posed by King Herod and entrusted him with loving and protecting Mary and the Baby Jesus. Immediately after God spoke to Joseph, he responded exactly as he was told. Based on this reflection, the "Sleeping Saint Joseph" devotion teaches us two valuable lessons: God calls us to rest and reflect in our lives—to break away from our busy lives. And when God gives us a message, we must act on it. *ITE AD SANCTUS IOSEPH!*

Ven. Fulton J. Sheen and Daily Holy Hour: Ven. Fulton J. Sheen began the practice of a daily Holy Hour when he was a seminarian. When he was ordained in 1919, he made a promise to make a Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament every day. Not only did Sheen never miss a Holy Hour during his sixty years of priesthood, but he died on December 9, 1979, in his private chapel while praying before the Blessed Sacrament. He had died as he had lived: in the presence of the Lord. In his autobiography, *Treasure in Clay*, he wrote: "It is impossible for me to explain how helpful the Holy Hour has been in preserving my vocation." He always encouraged this practice in others, even non-Catholics.

Be a Committed Adorer: Make a commitment to spend an hour or more every week with Our Lord in our Adoration Chapel! Go to <https://adorationpro.org/thereseca>, Click "Weekly Commitment," find the desired hour, click "Sign Up," and then fill out the form. You will receive an email or text reminder 24 hours before your committed time slot.

Keys to the Chapel | Security: If you have an electronic key and use the chapel after dark, please make sure you engage the lock when you enter so that the door cannot be opened without a key. Please do not let anyone whom you do not know follow you into the chapel if he/she doesn't have a key. This is an extremely important security issue.

QUIET LISTENING PRAYER THE INTERIOR CASTLE

The spiritual delights begin in God, but human nature feels and enjoys them as much as it does those I mentioned—and much more... Now I remember a line that we say at Prime, in the latter part of the verse at the end of the last psalm: Cum dilatasti cor meum. For anyone who has had much experience, these words are sufficient to see the difference between consolations and spiritual delights... The consolations that were mentioned do not expand the heart; rather, they usually seem to constrain it a little... But some anxious tears come that, in a way, seems to be brought on by the passions... My experience of this state (I mean of this joy and consolation that come during meditation) is that if I began to weep over the Passion, I didn't know how to stop until I got a severe headache; if I did so over my sins, the same thing happened... It is for these reasons sometimes that these tears flow and desires come, and they are furthered by human nature and one's temperament; but finally, as I have said, they end in God regardless of their nature. They are to be esteemed if there is humility to understand that one is no better because of experiencing them, for it cannot be known whether they are all effects of love. When they are, the gift is God's. For the most part, the souls in the previous dwelling places are the ones who have

these devout feelings, for these souls work almost continually with the intellect, engaging in discursive thought and meditation. And they do well because nothing further has been given them; although they would be right if they engaged for a while in making acts of love, praising God, rejoicing in His goodness, that He is who He is, and in desiring His honor and glory. These acts should be made insofar as possible, for they are great awakeners of the will. Such souls would be well advised when the Lord gives them these acts not to abandon them for the sake of finishing the usual meditation... In order to profit by this path and ascend to the dwelling places we desire, the important thing is not to think much but to love much; and so do that which best stirs you to love. Perhaps we don't know what love is. I wouldn't be very surprised, because it doesn't consist in great delight but in desiring with strong determination to please God in everything, in striving, insofar as possible, not to offend Him, and in asking Him for the advancement of the honor and glory of His Son and the increase of the Catholic Church. These are the signs of love. Don't think the matter lies in thinking of nothing else, and that if you become a little distracted, all is lost (IV,1,4-7).

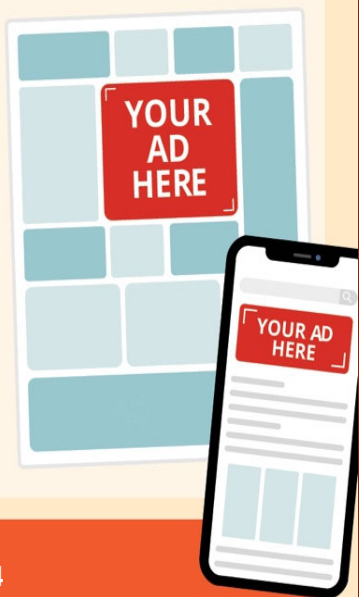

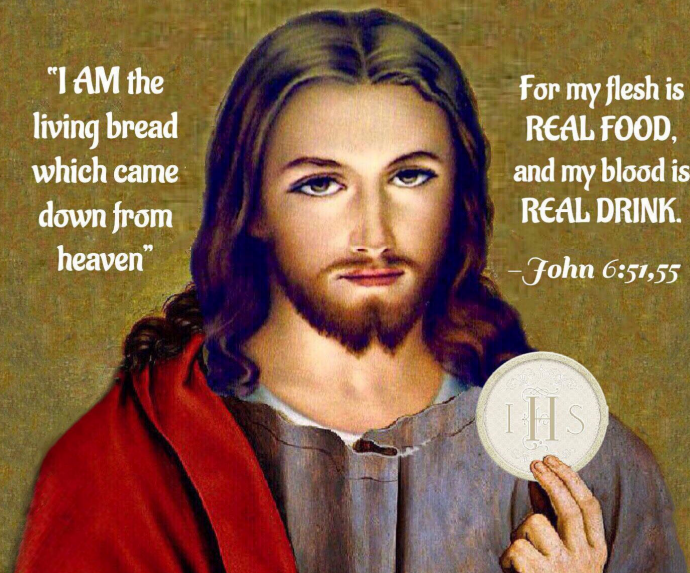

The Real St. Therese

On September 24, 1897, Mother Agnes thought that her sister may have had some intuition about the day she was going to die. She received this reply: "Ah! Mother, intuitions! If you only knew the poverty I'm in... But my soul, in spite of this darkness, is in astonishing peace."

This enduring trial that Therese referred to as a "black hole," (also as a "wall," a "tunnel," "fog," "night," and "darkness") made her enter into a more marked solitude. It was indescribable and incomprehensible and made her a stranger even to her own sisters. Even Mother Agnes herself, who was her confidante, could not gain access to this solitude. "You don't understand... God alone can understand me." Usually, she preferred to remain silent about it. Yet she did speak of it to a few persons: confessors, her Mother Prioress, Mother Agnes, Sister Genevieve, Sister Marie of the Trinity, Sister Therese of Saint-Augustine, and Sister Marie of the Sacred Heart. From the chaplain, her ordinary confessor, she received no consolation, rather the contrary: "Abbe, you told me with reference to my temptations against the faith: 'Don't dwell on these things, it's very dangerous!'" This was hardly consoling to hear, but happily she was "not affected by it."

Out of obedience, she also had told Mother Marie deGonzague, since she wrote in June: "Dear Mother, you know about this trial: I am going to speak to you about it again, however..." The Yellow Note-Book shows that with Mother Agnes, Therese was explicit, but very discreet. Up until the period in the infirmary, the "little Mother" had only known about it vaguely. Sister Genevieve was to say at the Apostolic Process: "She was tried by frightful temptations against the Faith which assailed her two years before her death and only ended with her life." Sister Therese of Saint-Augustine said, "She once told me something in confidence, which rather mystified me: 'If only you knew the darkness I am plunged into! I don't believe in eternal life; I think that after this life, there is nothing. Everything has disappeared on me, and I am left with Love alone.'"

Feast of Corpus Christi

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, (Latin for "Body of Christ"). This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264.

The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. The secondary focus is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. Jesus expresses this in the Gospels by using the metaphor of a body of which He is the head.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serve as a sign of common faith and belief in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood shows a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.

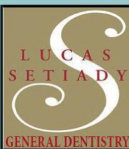
