STANDARDS

Reading/Writing

- Your child will be able to determine the central message or lesson in a fictional story.
- Your child will be able to answer who, what, why, when, where, and how from a fictional story with details and with help from a graphic organizer.
- Your child will be able to compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories.

Math

- Your child will be able to understand the meaning of the equal sign and determine if the equations, using addition and subtraction, are true or false.
- Your child will be able to use properties of operations as strategies to add and subtract within 20 (commutative property of addition, associative property of addition).
- Your child will be able to create a graph with three categories and ask and answer questions about the displayed data.

Science

- Your child will be able to understand that living and non-living things have distinct characteristics.
- Your child will understand how humans mimic plants and/or animals by using their external parts to help them survive, grow, and meet their needs.

Social Studies

- Your child will be able to identify individuals who are helpful to people in their everyday lives.
- Your child will name some responsibilities that students have at home and school.
