Leadership development is another cornerstone of the school's mission. The C.S. Lewis Honors Program offers a rigorous upper-school track grounded in critical thinking, classical dialogue, and a biblical worldview, while the Student Leadership Institute (SLi)—an ACSLI-affiliated program—mentors students in Christ-centered leadership through service, training, and responsibility.

This season of growth coincides with new leadership. Dr. Rick Brewer recently joined Master's Academy, bringing experience in Christian education, leadership development, and institutional growth. While the school's mission remains unchanged, Dr. Brewer's arrival comes at a pivotal moment—one marked by expansion, opportunity, and long-term vision.


