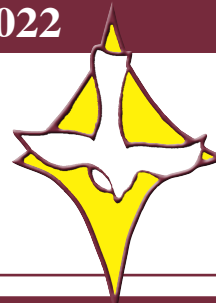

Weldon Jackson Tucker

(Dec. 20, 1979 – January 19, 2022)

Some Newsletters are harder to write than others...and this is one of them.

Weldon Jackson Tucker was born on December 20, 1979 in a small town in South Korea. He passed away on January 19, 2022 at Russell County Hospital in Russell Spring, KY. The impression he made on everyone he came in contact with cannot be accurately described. He was, nonverbal, deaf, autistic and in my opinion, a genius! Sandy and I adopted Weldon at the age of six years old.

Weldon had only one habit that could be bad...his addiction to coffee! Black or with cream, sugar or no sugar, hot or cold. It didn't matter to him as long as it was coffee. You couldn't sit a cup of coffee down around him and expect him to not find his way to it. You turn your head and next thing you know your cup is empty! Gone! He would drink every drop!

Our journey to adopting Weldon started when we (Mom & I) read an article in the Reader's Digest about him and how he was "smuggled" into the U.S. as a baby by a soldier in the U.S. Army and eventually ended up living in a home for older men. From

there he went onto foster care and that's when the story was published in Reader's Digest looking for a permanent home for Weldon. Mom and I knew right away that the Lord was calling us to give Weldon the loving home that he deserved.

Once we started the process, everything fell into place and it wasn't too much longer that Weldon joined our family and was a blessing from then on.

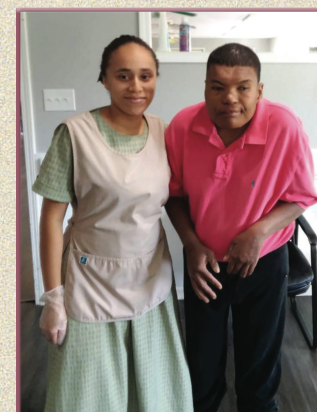
