- ▶ Beginning next Wednesday, November 13, roadwork will begin on Easton Avenue. Gas lines are being replaced. This will not affect the Hickory Street parking for pickup. However, we believe it will affect the single-entry line coming of Easton Avenue for the second wave of pickup. 

Questions...and Answers:

What day can I come to visit Bethlehem Catholic?

Students can visit beginning in the first full week of September. The program will continue throughout the year. We may restrict students from coming on days when we have special schedules or no academic classes.

Where do I go on my visitation day?

The Bethlehem Catholic school day is from 8:00 am until 2:30 pm. You should arrive at the school's Main Entrance at 8:30 am. Once you arrive, you will meet Mrs. Calantoni, Director of Admissions, in the Main Office. Shortly after your arrival, you will be introduced to your BECAHI guide for the day. Your day will end at about 2:00 pm with a wrap-up interview to discuss your experience.

What should I wear?

If you go to a Catholic grade school, you wear your grade school uniform. Otherwise, please dress in smart casual attire.

Should I bring anything with me?


Lunch is on us when you visit so the only thing you really need to bring is your enthusiasm for the day!
