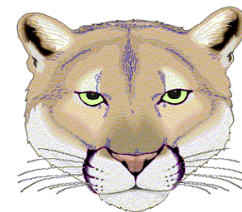

Yearbooks are \$20 until April 15th. After 4/15, they will go up to \$25 each. Limited amount

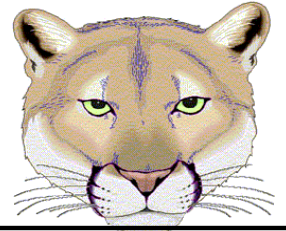

5th and 6th Grade	11:15AM

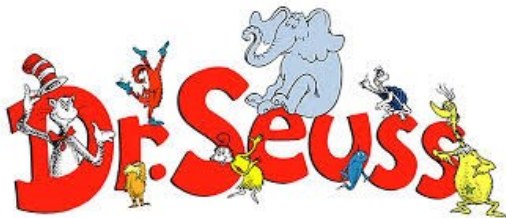
All proceeds will go to Smoketree PTSO, to help purchase a Sound System and curtains for the GYM, along with Playground Student Activities.

No change will be given

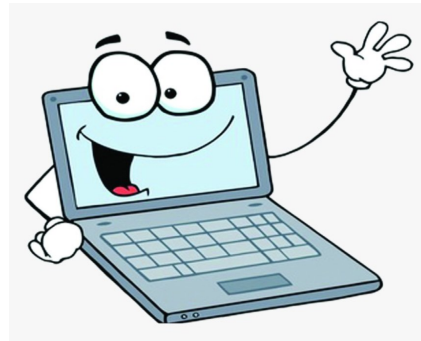
Then stay for the Read-In in your child's classroom from 8:00AM—9:00AM. We will also have guest readers from our community visiting the classrooms.

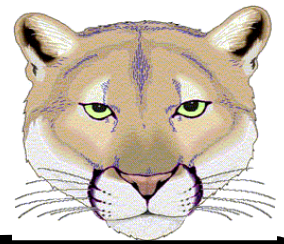

Home-Based Symptom Screening

Parents: If your child has any of the following symptoms, they might have an illness they can spread to others.

Check your child for these symptoms before they go to school.

Check a symptom only if it has changed from usual or baseline health.

Is your child too sick for school?

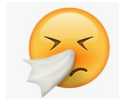
- Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- Sore throat
- Cough (for students with chronic cough due to allergies or asthma, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Difficulty breathing (for students with asthma, a change from their baseline breathing)
- Diarrhea or vomiting
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

If your child HAS any of the symptoms above:

Keep them home from school. Consider whether your child needs to see a healthcare provider and possible COVID-19 testing. CDC has a [Coronavirus Self Checker](#)* available in its website, which may help you make decisions about seeking medical care for possible COVID-19.

Contact your child's school and report that your child is sick. The school may ask some additional questions to help determine when it is safe for your child to return to school. If your child does NOT have any of the symptoms above: Send them to school as usual.
