OPEN MEETING NOTICE RESOLUTION 2014-0001

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1 (c), NMSA 1978 requires this Board to determine at least annually "what notice for a public meeting shall be reasonable";

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved this 12th day of June, 2013, by the Board of Education of the Roy Municipal School District, as follows:

Regular meetings of the Board of Education shall be held on the second Wednesday of each calendar month, with the exceptions of March and April when the meeting shall be held on the 3rd Wednesday. A Special meeting may be called by the President or at the request of three (3) or more Board members. In emergency situations, the President, the Superintendent or his designee may call for a meeting upon reasonable notice as described hereafter. All meetings shall be held in the Board Room of the Roy Municipal Schools, Roy, New Mexico, unless otherwise indicated on the notice. Regular meetings shall begin at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of all regular meetings shall be given by publishing this resolution once a year in a legal newspaper of general circulation within the school district. Notice of regular and special meetings shall be posted in the Village of Post Office, Community 1st Bank, and the Central Office of the Roy Municipal Schools, at least 10 days prior to the regular meeting, the agendas will be available 72 hours prior to the meeting by contacting the School Office. Special Meetings notices will be posted along with the agendas three (3) days prior to the meeting. Notice of all emergency meetings shall be given to each Board Member in writing or personally at least 24 hours prior to the time of the meeting. In addition, notice of all emergency meetings shall be given to the public by posting notice of the meeting at the above listed locations at least six (6) hours prior to such meeting.
