



Common Accommodations for EdOptions Academy Students with IEPs

There are tools that all students can use during instruction. They are in the tool box on the left side of the screen:

1. Table of contents (click on a topic to jump to it)
 2. Notes (take electronic notes)
 3. Resources (includes a glossary & course-specific information sheets like Geometric Sequences, Geometric Series Formulas)
 4. Dictionary
 5. Reader (slide narration or click to speak)
 6. Translator
 7. Calculator
 8. Math Tools: Making Graphs, Making Data Plots
 9. Highlighter (4 colors)
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- ❖ Use outlines and/or graphic organizers for writing assignments like discussions & unit/course activities.
 - ❖ Mastery tests may be taken multiple times as needed (for all students).
 - ❖ Retake post-tests more than 2 times if needed, possibly odd number one day and even number another.
 - ❖ Revisit post-test to check missed and correct answers.
 - ❖ Retake the EOS (final) exam up to 2 times instead of 1 time.
 - ❖ Post-tests or the EOS exam can be taken in more than one sitting.
 - ❖ Use assistive browser extensions, such as text to speech, for read aloud (<https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/select-and-speak-text-to/gfjopfpjmkcfgjpogepmdjmcnihfpokn>)
 - ❖ Check-in synchronously with instructor through phone and webinars (Zoom).
 - ❖ Use block scheduling such as working with science one day, math another and so forth.
 - ❖ Submit discussions in different formats such text, audio recordings, drawings, and etc.
 - ❖ Reduce the number of unit activities on a case-by-cases basis. (Based on student needs and IEP team determination). This can be handled in Courseware by dropping a grade instead of exempting for accurate calculation purposes.
