

Attention: 7th Grade Math Students

Opportunity for High School Credit Algebra I

CCMS offers an opportunity for students to participate in an accelerated math program. Students in this program will take one high school credit course in 8th grade – Honors Algebra I.

Qualifying students will take an Algebra I placement test in the Spring of their 7th grade year. Students must qualify to take the placement test based on their 7th grade math grades.

ONLY 7th grade students with a math grade of 90% and higher Semester 1 average <u>and</u> also a 90% and higher for the 3rd quarter are invited to take the placement test.

A student's score on the placement test and their performance on the state's TCAP Math assessment in 7th grade will be used to determine placement into Algebra I for the following year.

If a student qualifies for Algebra I, parents will be informed and given the opportunity to accept or decline placement into the high school credit Algebra I class for their 8th grade school year.
