- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, our first graders will progress from 13% at or above grade level in reading to 80% at or above grade level according to iReady assessments.
- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year our second graders will increase from 23% at or above grade level in ELA to 72% at or above grade level according to i-Ready assessments.
- Increase proficiency scores on the ACAP in ELA to 75% and in Math to 60% with a focus on reading foundational skills and operations with numbers.
- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, our first graders will progress from 5% at or above grade level in math to 74% at or above grade level according to iReady assessments.
- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year our second graders will increase from 10% at or above grade level in math to 70% at or above grade level in math according to i-Ready assessments.
