## Addendum \#3 - Informational answers to questions from the February 8 Walk-throughs

1. Types of cabinets in IDF - Lockable and mounted just below the ceiling.
2. Was asked what kind of conduit requested for drops - Medal Conduit/EMT used if cables come down the wall.
3. Add an IDF at ECHS in Room 100 with lockable wall mount cabinet - required due to length of the run. Less than 5 other IDF's may need to be moved because currently located in a classroom.
4. Fiber run from one building to another - if fiber leaves one building and runs to another our options:
a. Use Existing underground pipe if available.
b. Preferred underground in PVC for new pulls
c. If an arial/overhead needs to be run place in conduit attached to awning
5. Cabling Color - different than existing blue Cat with standard colors for patch cables in the closet.
6. Deinstallation of old equipment and cabling that is being replaced. Hallways may be problematic when it is bundled inside other cabling - please remove with caution to the best of your ability.
