***Interview of Mr. Terrence Snider
Principal of Hemingway High School
and Hemingway M.B. Lee Middle
School***



Q: What should parents expect when their children attend your school this year?

A: Parents should expect for their children to learn in a safe, nurturing, caring, and conducive environment. They should also expect for their children to receive high quality and standards-based instruction consistently.

Q: What does a typical school day look like for you as a principal?
