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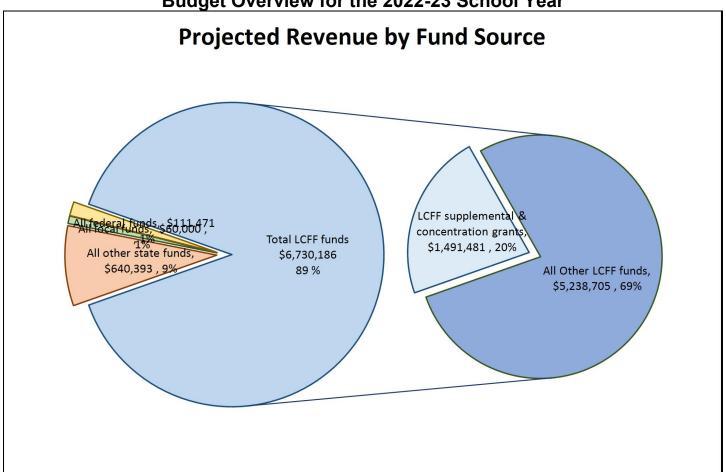

School districts receive funding from different sources: state funds under the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), other state funds, local funds, and federal funds. LCFF funds include a base level of funding for all LEAs and extra funding - called "supplemental and concentration" grants - to LEAs based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learners, and low-income students).





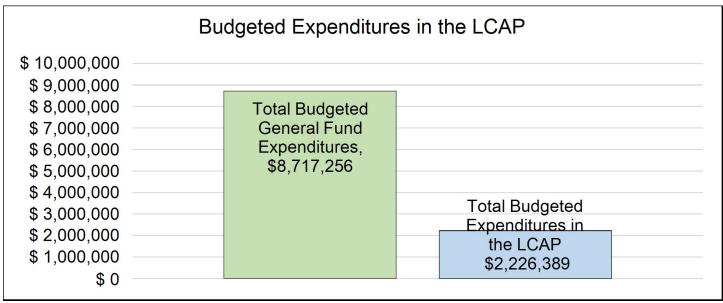
This chart shows the total general purpose revenue Oak Valley UESD expects to receive in the coming vear from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for Oak Valley UESD is \$7,542,050, of which \$6,730,186 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$640,393 is other state funds, \$60,000 is local funds, and \$111,471 is federal funds. Of the \$6,730,186 in LCFF Funds, \$1,491,481 is

generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

This chart provides a quick summary of how much Oak Valley UESD plans to spend for 2022-23. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.

The text description of the above chart is as follows: Oak Valley UESD plans to spend \$8,717,256 for the 2022-23 school year. Of that amount, \$2,226,389 is tied to actions/services in the LCAP and \$6,490,867 is not included in the LCAP. The budgeted expenditures that are not included in the LCAP will be used for the following:

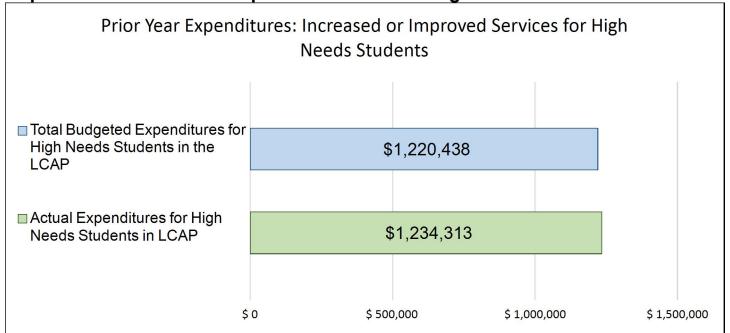

Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in the LCAP for the 2022-23 School Year

In 2022-23, Oak Valley UESD is projecting it will receive \$1,491,481 based on the enrollment of foster youth, English learner, and low-income students. Oak Valley UESD must describe how it intends to increase or improve services for high needs students in the LCAP.
