

Soliciting Prices, Bids and Quotations

The North Canaan Board of Education will require written quotations on purchase of goods or services ranging in cost from one thousand to fifteen thousand dollars. Purchases involving an obligation in excess of fifteen thousand dollars will be made on the basis of sealed proposals. Such sealed proposals may be required on purchases of lesser amounts at the Board's discretion and the Board also reserves the right to waive the bid process entirely.

Such quotation or bid requirement will not apply to textbook purchases, which are based upon specific content and which are approved by the Board prior to purchase, or to a standard list of supply items on which quality has been predetermined. Bids are also not required on purchases where only one supplier exists, architectural services, legal services, and services requiring expertise (consultants and specialists).

The right is reserved to accept partial bids, to award bids on a total-bid basis, to reject any or all bids as submitted, to negotiate changes, and to make such selection of materials or equipment as is, in the best judgment of the North Canaan School Board or its purchasing agent, best suited for the purposes intended.
