1. Call To Order

The workshop was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Steve Scott, at 4:32 p.m.

2. Financial Information

Mrs. Wood stated that the Skyward conversion was ongoing. She stated that employee access has been completed and open for all full-time employees. She stated that 100% of all regular payroll employees are on paperless payroll as of July 1st. She stated that all changes to benefits should be complete and will reflect on the October paycheck. She stated that the operational audit for processes and systems are complete. She shared with the Board the term of agreement with the GCCTA regarding the retention bonus pay. She stated that the district is working diligently to give teachers their classroom supply monies. She stated that there are approximately 11 international teachers on payroll. She stated that the district received a check in the amount of \$114,097.66 for Hurricane Michael relief efforts. She stated that the old agriculture building was being used as the cafeteria for Gadsden Elementary Magnet School. She stated that the district received the Fresh Fruit Award for the 2019 – 2020 year.
