Helpful Hints

-When *qh* comes at the beginning of a word, it has the sound /q/ (*qhost*).

-When *qh* comes at the end of a word, it sometimes has the sound /f/ (*lauqh*).

-When the vowel *i* comes before *qh*, the *i* is long, and the *qh* is silent (*high; night*). This is the case for most *qh* words.

-When y is followed by one or two consonants, the vowel sound is short i. (qym)

- When y is alone at the end of a one-syllable word, and there are no other vowels, the sound is long i. (fly)
