## La Gloria ISD School Supply List 2024-2025

Backpack – mesh or clear preferred but not required

1 Zippered 3 Ring Binder (4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade only)

La Gloria ISD will provide the basic consumable supplies to all students like paper, pencils, colors, markers, folders, binders, and pens, but encourages parents to buy their student any of the basic consumable supplies if preferred, and/or to have at home.

## La Gloria ISD Dress and Grooming (All Grade Levels)

The district's dress code teaches grooming and hygiene, prevents disruption, and minimizes safety hazards. La Gloria ISD administration highly recommends students wear comfortable but appropriate pants or shorts, tennis shoes, and have a see-through backpack. Any school spirit t-shirt (La Gloria, Premont, Falfurrias schools preferred), college spirit t-shirts, polos or t-shirts of any color, jeans, khakis, and appropriate shorts are highly encouraged.

Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

- 1. Hair must be neat, well-groomed, and not covering the face and eyes. Distracting hairstyles such as spiked mohawks, unnatural hair color (such as pink, blue, metallic red, green, and purple), and inappropriate shaved hair designs are disallowed. Facial hair on boys is disallowed.
- All clothing or any worn item or displayed will not denote membership of affiliation in a gang or social club, will not depict Satan, Satanic rites, death, sadism, evil, violence, weapons, pornography, drugs, tobacco, alcohol, prohibited substances, lewd images or comments, offensive images or comments, vulgarity, obscenity, nor adult-themed content. Any tattoos must be covered or not visible.
- 3. Tank tops/crop tops/spaghetti straps/sleeveless shirts for boys, or exposed mid-riffs are disallowed. Athletic bra-style tops for females must be covered with an appropriate shirt or blouse. Tops and blouses may be of any color and style within the dress code.



- 4. Jeans and pants with exposed holes or rips that reveal skin are disallowed. Any color and style of pants or jeans may be worn. All bottom clothing must fit appropriately and not reveal underwear or mid-riff. Leggings and athletic bottoms such as sweat pants are allowed. Leggings must be worn with an appropriate t-shirt, blouse, dress, or skirt that modestly covers the waist-line, crotch, and buttocks.
- 5. Any color or style of shorts, skirts, and dresses for students must be modest and fall no shorter than mid-thigh on a student.
- 6. Shoes- La Gloria ISD highly recommends students wear tennis shoes daily, due to the requirement in physical education classes and safety concerns. Tennis shoes are required for PE classes, and following PE dress code is a small part of the PE class grade given by the teacher. Students wearing any other type of shoe must have tennis shoes to change into for PE classes. Shoes that are disallowed are sandals without a backstrap, flip-slops, slides, steel-toe boots, heeled shoes above an inch. Crocs are allowed but must be worn with socks.
- 7. Jewelry La Gloria highly recommends students do not wear any jewelry for movement and safety concerns in physical education classes, as well as we are unable to guarantee or cover the value of lost or stolen jewelry. Facial piercings and gauges are disallowed for all students. Only girls may wear one pair of small earrings/studs so that they are less likely to get caught or hung up on clothing or other things, like a backpack. Generally speaking, necklaces, bracelets, and rings are allowed for students unless a teacher or the principal deems it as dangerous, such as a spiked bracelet or ring.
- 8. Hats, caps, and sunglasses are disallowed inside buildings.
- 9. Backpacks should be appropriate to the student's size, and comply with general guidelines described in Dress Code Rule #2 above. Mesh or plastic see-through backpacks are highly encouraged but not required.

The superintendent/principal will make any final decision on dress code matters up for interpretation or not specifically covered in the rules.
