



## grading Students will be given letter grades in Math and Language Arts. 60% major, 40% minor for Reading and Math Students will be given an S, N, or U in Handwriting, Science, and Social Studies. Students will have to pass Language Arts and Math with a yearly average of 60% or higher to be promoted to second grade.
