Tuesday: Multiplication quiz- 10s

Thursday: Language Test- past-tense verbs, abbreviations and titles

Friday: Reading Skills Test- the skills' test is a cold read test (passages they have never seen); vocabulary on the test will be bonus points

How do I prepare for the tests?

Math- Study multiplication facts daily. Study the math sheets in the folder in the math binder daily.

Language- Study the language sheets in the binder daily. Save these sheets to study.

Reading- Study vocabulary and skills listed on the newsletter, study vocabulary definitions and use Quizlet to study as well. Also, study reading skills by using online websites we use, like commonlit.org.

Vocabulary:

suffix-word part added to end of word that changes word meaning, **main idea-**most important point the author makes about the topic, **key details-** supports and tells about the main idea, **genre-** type of text, **text evidence** – information found within the text that supports your answer, **summarize-** telling the most important ideas and details in a text, **-able-** can be, **-ful-** full of, **-ly-** in a certain manner or way, like, **-y-** full of
