How do I prepare for the tests?

**Math-** Study multiplication facts daily. Study the math sheets in the folder in the math binder daily.

## Vocabulary:

suffix-word part added to end of word that changes word meaning, main idea-most important point the author makes about the topic, key details— supports and tells about the main idea, genre— type of text, text evidence — information found within the text that supports your answer, summarize— telling the most important ideas and details in a text, -able— can be, -ful—full of, -ly—in a certain manner or way, like, -y—full of
