The ETSU Application is Open

Your ETSU-bound students may now apply for admission for Fall 2023 at etsu.edu/apply. Official transcripts are required to complete the application.

Transcripts: School officials may submit documents by email to documents@etsu.edu, or through an electronic transcript sharing services such as Parchment, or through postal mail. Students may not submit documents by email.

Test Scores: ETSU is now test-optional. However, students are encouraged to submit an ACT or SAT score to be considered for scholarships. A test score may be required for certain academic programs.
