POSITION STATUS:

This is a temporary position for the 2022-23 school year that is funded through a grant obtained by the Vernonia School District. Pay is based on experience and education/training related to the Classified and Certified contract, up to 30 hours a week.

- Serve as a positive role model to students, staff and parents.
