ACT Prep Syllabus Instructor: Melissa Reel

Course Description:

ACT Prep is designed to assist students in preparing for the ACT. By law, all Tennessee students are expected to take a college entrance exam by high school graduation. To fulfill this requirement, BCHS students take the ACT in the spring of their junior year and again in the fall of their senior year.

The ACT consists of four subject areas:

- 1) English 75 questions 45 minutes
- 2) Math 60 questions 60 minutes
- 3) Reading 40 questions 35 minutes
- 4) Science 40 questions 35 minutes

To prepare for these tests, each student will complete practice exams, engage in group discussion, become the teacher in the class, and assist others in understanding the ACT questions and concepts.

I NEED TO SHARPEN MY PENCIL?
