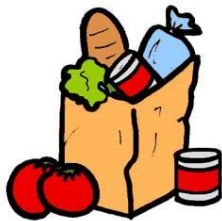


**MEETING:** Our next meeting will be on Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup> after Mass.
