WHAT IS TELEMEDICINE?

Telemedicine uses the latest computer technology, software, digital telecommunications, and medical devices (Stethoscopes, Otoscope, Pulse Ox, etc.) which enables providers to evaluate, diagnose, and treat patients through our video conferencing platform.

WHAT'S IT FOR?

As parents of school-aged children, it is inevitable to receive a call from the school announcing you have a sick child to pick up. Thus, the chaos for many ensues: Taking time off work, transportation issues, finding back-up care for sibling(s) while you wait for hours at a Drs. Office or ER (exposing you and your child to other illnesses) - the list goes on and on.
