
Jami is a member of Pleasant View Baptist Church in Carrollton. After graduation, she plans to attend the State University of West Georgia.

The Lions' split season does not reflect the winning attitude of this team. The 1999 Lions played with the heart of a champion and now begin building the foundation for the 2000 season.




