SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OCTOBER 20, 2025 @ 6:00 P.M.

The Webster County Board of Education held a special called meeting on October 20, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. Linda Rogers, Donald Brown, Jimmie Johnson, and James McCullough, Interim Superintendent, were present. Landon Matthews was present via phone.

Linda Rogers called the regular session to order at 6:00 P.M.

A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

No visitors were present

The Board approved the tentative agenda for October 20, 2025 with the exception to add the approval to accept Mary Hinman's resignation to the agenda. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

The Board approved to enter executive session to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee or to interview applicants for the position of Superintendent. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown to enter executive session. The motion carried unanimously.

No action was taken in executive session. There was a consultation with the Board and Helms and McCorkle, LLC on the process for the Superintendent search.

The Board approved to accept the resignation of Mary Hilman. A motion was made by Jimmie Johnson and seconded by Donald Brown. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:29 p.m. with a motion by Donald Brown and seconded by Landon Matthews. The motion carried unanimously.
