Here's how:

Step 1

Buy gift cards or e-cards for things you regularly purchase: groceries, gas, restaurants, travel, clothes, shopping, etc.

Step 2

Earn tuition credits for yourself, and money for our school, with every order.

Step 3

How Does the Program Work?

PART is a fundraising program that works as a partnership between the school and school families, and benefits both. St. George PART buys gift cards at a discounted rate through local retailers and from our broker, RaiseRight. Every retailer offers a certain rebate amount. The school splits the rebate with you 50/50!

- → Families purchase cards through the PART program at face value.
 - → PART receives a discount on those cards.
- → The school splits that discount with you: half of the discount amount is applied as a credit to your tuition account, and the other half goes to the school.

Example:

Macy's offers a 10% rebate

You purchase a \$100 Macy's gift card at face value

The total rebate amount is \$10

The \$10 rebate is split 50/50 between you and the school:

\$5 credit goes towards your tuition account

\$5 goes to the school

There are hundreds of retailers available!

Every single purchase made earns tuition credit!

Earn tuition credits while using money...

- √ that you have already budgeted
- ✓ that you are already planning to spend
- ✓ at exactly the same places you already shop & dine

Tuition Credits

Credits are applied quarterly for every family who has used PART that quarter.

Quarters end on September 30, December 31, March 31 & June 30.

Credits are processed as quickly as possible after a quarter-end, but it may take a week or two.

Once the credit is processed, it is deducted from the remaining balance on your BlackBaud Tuition account.

Q: How can I earn as much as possible towards tuition? A: Use PART regularly + Make it a habit!

Our families who earn the highest tuition credits:

- √ Buy grocery cards weekly
- ✓ Purchase gas cards regularly
- ✓ Use the e-card and reload functions through the mobile app
- ✓ Are in the habit of always checking the retailer list at <u>www.raiseright.com</u> before making any purchases, big or small

Traveling?

Earn a huge rebate by buying your airline or hotel gift cards through PART, then use those to pay on the travel websites.

Need a new household appliance?

Check out which retailers have PART cards available, and purchase through PART before paying at home improvement stores.

Fundraising Requirement

PART can help you fulfill your fundraising requirement for the school year!

Every school family is required to sell Strike It Rich raffle tickets in Winter/Spring 2026

In addition, you must choose one of two options to raise an extra \$100 per family this school year:

1) Earn a \$100 credit for the school using PART

i.e. Earn a total credit of \$200: \$100 earned towards tuition/\$100 earned for school

- OR -

2) Sell an extra \$100 worth of Strike It Rich tickets

If you choose to sell extra tickets and do not sell them all, the amount will be added to your tuition account.

If you choose the PART requirement, the \$100 school credit must be met by the last earning quarter for the current school year, which ends on March 31st.

This does NOT mean that you only have to purchase \$100 worth of gift cards!

The rebates earned over the course of the year must add up to at least \$200 total – meaning you've earned at least \$100 off your tuition, and \$100 for the school.

If you commit to the PART requirement and do not earn the full \$100 credit for the school, the difference will be added to your final tuition payment due in May.

You have 12 months to accumulate the credits every school year. This school year's PART program runs from April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026.

You can still use the PART program, even if you choose to sell extra Strike It Rich tickets as your extra fundraising requirement!

Additional Notes

- ✓ **Download the RaiseRight mobile app** from the app store, and have easy access to ordering physical cards, e-cards & reloads right from your phone!
- ✓ If a check is returned NSF, the family will be responsible for the bank fee. Any current orders will be held until payment is made. If a family has more than two NSF checks in one quarter, payment by cash is required on future orders.
 - ✓ Grandparents and family members can also sign up for the PART program and help earn tuition credits for your students as well!
