### Tiger Den Floor Dedicated to Coaches Berger and Roslansky

Tri-Township Schools supporters packed the Tiger Den last Friday night to honor two men whose influence reach far beyond classrooms, gymnasiums, wins and championships. In a moving unveiling ceremony, the basketball floor was officially dedicated to longtime coaches and teachers Bill Berger and Ken Roslansky.

Superintendent Dr. Paige McNulty expressed that the historic occasion was another reason to celebrate the legacy of the school corporation. "Tonight's tribute was centered not on records, but on impact," said McNulty. "Great teachers and coaches often become legends in their school communities due to the lives they change. In this case, these gentlemen hold both titles, which is simply amazing."

Tri-Township High School Principal Brian McMahan opened the evening by reminding those in attendance that a gym is more than a playing surface. "This is where preparation is tested and discipline is formed," McMahan said. "It's where young people learn what it means to compete, to respond to adversity, and to represent something bigger than themselves."

School Board President Tim Guse spoke on behalf of the board, describing the dedication as a recognition of legacy and character. Guse, who had the honor of being taught by Roslansky, reflected personally on the influence both men had on their students. "This evening is about far more than a name on hardwood," Guse said. "It is about the quiet, steady work of shaping lives — day after day, season after season, generation after generation. Great teachers build knowledge and great coaches build skill — but exceptional ones build people. They taught us how to show up, how to prepare, how to stay disciplined, how to support teammates, and how to keep going when things get hard. Those lessons don't fade, they become part of who you are."

The emotional highlight of the evening came as varsity boys basketball players unveiled the names on the court resulting in a standing ovation filled with applause. Former players and coaches lined up to greet Berger and Roslansky, offering handshakes and embraces.

"I've seen their impact as a student, as a colleague, and as an administrator," added McMahan. "I am the person I am today because of these men." Moving forward, every basketball game will be introduced as "Welcome to the Tiger Den and Coach Berger Court," and every volleyball match as "Welcome to the Tiger Den and Coach Roslansky Court."
