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ED GEPA 427 Statement: Troy School District 2023-2024

Troy School District uses federal funds to pay salaries for instructional staff to provide interventions in the area of ELA and Math to support all students, school-wide, grades k-12, as needed to master standards. Students enter each grade at a variety of levels, and not all of them are proficient on the state assessments. As they enter the new grade level, students are given universal screeners to help staff identify those in need of additional support and individualize their learning needs both at school and at home.

Using a reteach model, TSD will give students not meeting grade level proficiency (tier 1, tier 2, and tier 3), regardless of gender, race, national origin, color, disability, or age, access to master standards using different teaching strategies, additional exposure and practice, additional time, individual and small group instructional support. Student progress is monitored and instruction adjusted as needed throughout the year.
