

Is your child ready for K4?

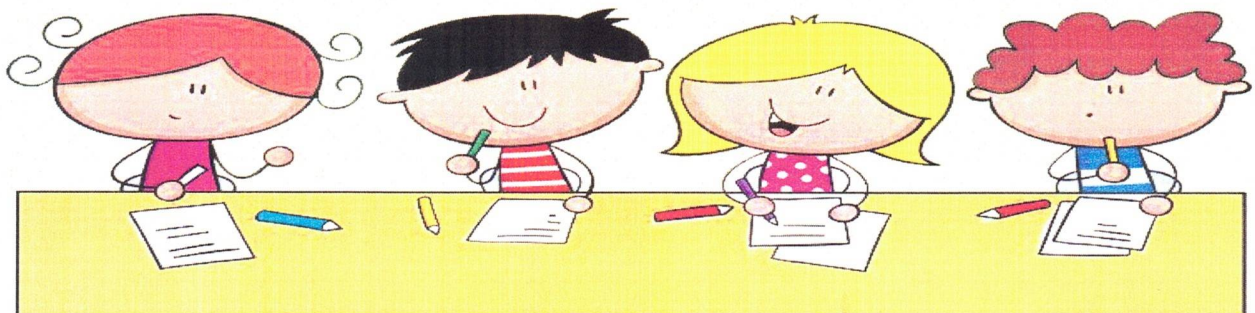
Please work with your child on:

Ideas for name practice:

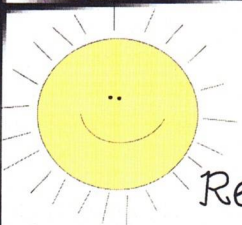
- Have your child use magnetic letters to build his/her name.

For Rising K4 students

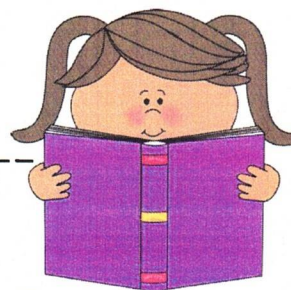
