★ OUR LEARNING

Reading- I can identify the main idea and retell key details. I can understand the author's purpose. I can identify stanzas and line breaks in poems

Phonics- I can read and write words with oo. I can read words with inflectional endings.

Writing: I can research and write an informative text. I can identify possessive nouns. I can use commas in sentences and dates.

Math- I can find the missing part in equations. I can identify 2-D and 3-D shapes and their attributes. I can tell to the hour and half hour. I can balance equations.

Science/Social Studies- I can research topics that interest me.
