About Measure C-2004

Measure C-2004 is a \$79 million bond measure authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the schools within the Santa Maria Joint Union High School District. Measure C-2004 allows the Santa Maria Joint Union High School District (SMJUHS D) to make the following improvements throughout the District:

- Construct a new high school to reduce existing overcrowding
- Make health and safety improvements at existing schools such as upgrading fire alarms and making ADA improvements
- Improve student access to computers and modern technology
- Complete repair and upgrade projects at the existing high schools, including renovating, plumbing, upgrading electrical systems, and repairing and/or replacing roofs
- Make the District eligible to receive over \$30 million in State grants.

Purpose:

California State Law requires that a Citizens' Oversight Committee be appointed by the Board of Trustees within 60 days of certification of the election results. The purpose of the Oversight Committee is:

- To actively monitor all Measure C-2004 projects and expenditures
- To provide proper oversight, controls, and accountability to ensure that Measure C-2004 funds are used as they were intended
- To make regular reports to the community at large on the progress of Measure C-2004 projects.

Duties of the Committee:

Members of the Citizens' Oversight Committee will meet on a regular basis to provide input regarding overall program, budget and financing, management, and construction schedules. Responsibilities may include the following:

- Ensure Measure C-2004 funds are spent only on projects listed in the Measure C-2004 project list and that no funds are used for any teacher or administrative salaries or general school operating expenses.
- Advise District staff on specific projects, as well as the overall SMJUHS D plans.
- Follow and monitor Measure C-2004 projects.
- Receive and review copies of the annual performance and financial audits of Measure C-2004.
- Inspect school facilities and grounds to ensure compliance with Measure C-2004.
- Review deferred maintenance plans to the district.
- Provide information to the public on the progress of Measure C-2004 projects.
