LeFlore Magnet High School supports and enforces a simple uniform policy. Students who violate the uniform policy will face disciplinary actions. Uniforms must be worn to and from school, except for physical education classes and/or special events that are authorized by school administration.

Uniform Tops (Store: Zoghby's or Uniform R Us)	 9th grade: white polo or white button-down shirt with long or short sleeves 10th grade: orange polo or orange button-down shirt with long or short sleeves 11th grade: orange polo or orange button-down shirt with long or short sleeves 12th grade: green polo or green button-down shirt with long or short sleeves Shirts must be tucked in; no colored or imprinted undershirts that show through outer

	BOTTOMS
Uniforms Bottoms	Khaki standard uniform slacks, such as a "Docker style" slack; cotton or blend twill; fitted and belted at waist; full length to ankle; no Capri lengths; no jean or cargo

BELTS/SOCKS	Belts: any color (black/brown encouraged)

SHOES	Any color closed toe shoes
ID BADGE	Must be worn and visible at all times
PROFESSIONAL DAY	Students may dress in approved Professional Day attire or regular school uniform

	Khaki pants or khaki skirts (must fall to the knees)

OUTERWEAR	Outerwear: Solid color black, gray, orange, or green; or a LeFlore approved outerwear purchased through our school store
	Cardigans: Hunter green or orange
	Blazers: Hunter green
	Hoodies are not allowed for outerwear.
Bookbags	Clear bookbags or mesh bookbags only this school year.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

The following items are prohibited: All Head Gear, Hats, Hair Bonnets/Scarves, Crocs, Hair Rollers, Blankets, Skirts/Skorts (except Wednesday), Jumpers, Sunglasses, Face Paint, Ski Masks, Flip Flops, Backless Shoes, House Shoes, Slippers, Facial Jewelry (earrings are acceptable), Open Toe Shoes, clothing with any type of writing on in.

Strongly encouraged: Natural hair color and hair at or above waist length

ATHLETES

Athletes are to wear appropriate game day attire on game days only according to directives from their coach. School uniforms are required if game day attire is not approved by coach.
