The scholarship provides academic and financial support to Arizona's first-generation college students. The Program funds up to 60 awards annually for incoming freshmen attending Arizona State University – Tempe, Northern Arizona University – Flagstaff, and University of Arizona – Tucson. The award includes \$12,000/year for four years, a semester abroad, academic support, and other enrichment opportunities. More than 700 students have received a Dorrance Scholarship since 1999.



- Agree to live in on-campus housing during freshman and sophomore year
